Implementing Universal Design Principles in Your Teaching



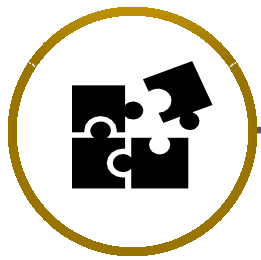
Aware

- Teaching practices that might unknowingly reflect personal bias



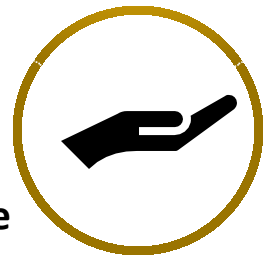
Cultivate

- Explicit course expectation
- Respectful learning environment
 - Equity-oriented, culturally accepted materials



Create

- Course design for impactful teaching
- Multiple means of representation and accessible materials
- Universally designed teaching strategies and engagement
- Assessments with multiple means of expression



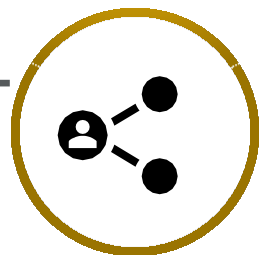
Enable

- A positive classroom climate
- Culturally responsive teaching
 - Language and interactions
 - Discussion of difficult topics
