

Creating a Coursera Assignment (GwG) outside of Canvas

Be sure you have reviewed all relevant *GwG* content before assigning coursework to ensure the courses and modules fit the course learning objectives.


Instructors have 2 options for reporting grades from Coursera to Canvas:

- Within the Canvas environment, instructors can assign specific modules from programs
- Outside of Canvas, instructors need to identify complete programs or specific courses and modules for students to complete. Student submission/completion needs to be shared through screenshots or other instructor-decided paths.


Follow the steps below to assign your *Grow with Google (GwG)* content outside of the Canvas environment:

- 1. Click the Grow with Google link you found in the email from Coursera
- 2. Select Join Now and login with your UCCS credentials
- 3. Click Join Program on the next window.





All 7 Certificates will appear.







4. Select the specific program you want to assign to your students.




5. Choose the specific course or courses.



6. Select the module or modules to complete. Once the student has completed the module and activity, a grade will populate in the student's Coursera gradebook.





- Assignments are automatically graded using 100 points to match the GwG structure.
- You must set due dates in the Canvas assignment. The Coursera due date does not sync with Canvas; please advise students.
- Students can complete any other *GwG* program that is available while their UCCS license is active.
