

Enabling New Quizzes in Your Canvas Course

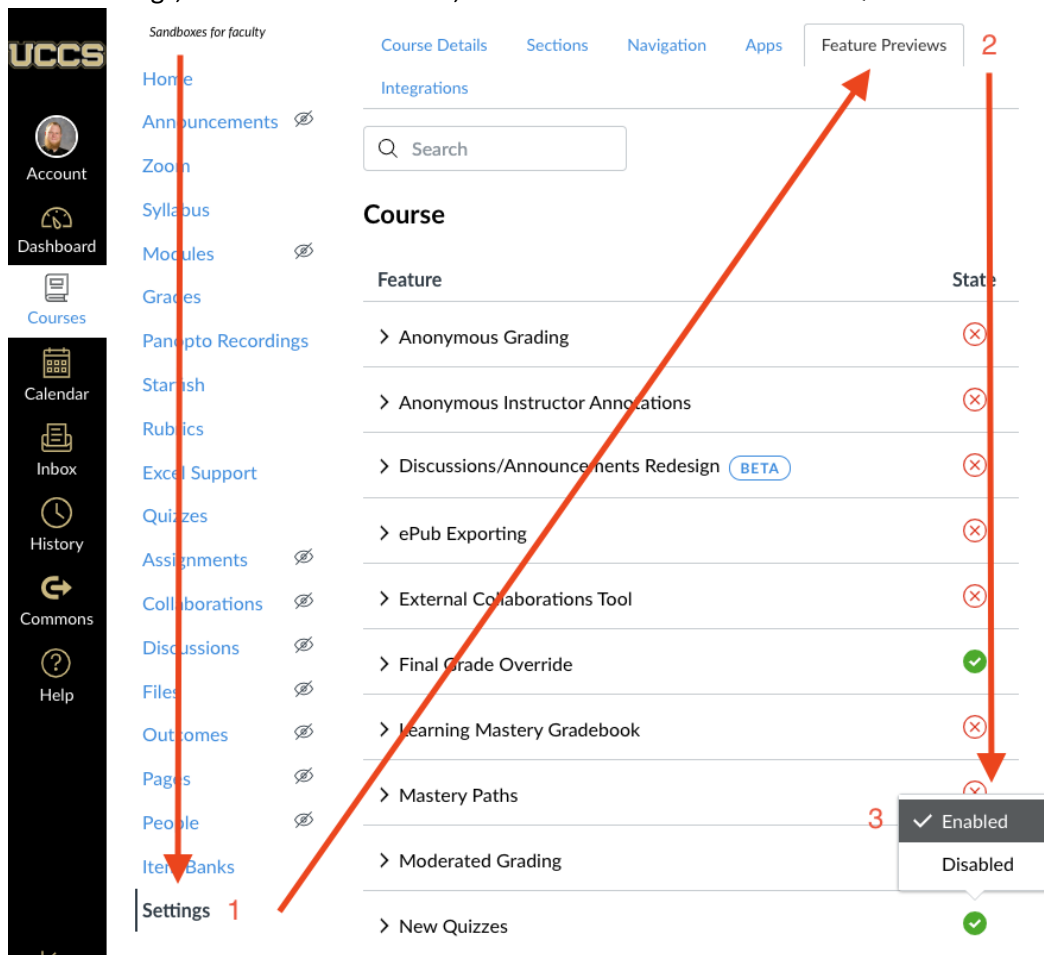
First, a comparison of some features:

| Classic Quizzes | New Quizzes |
|-----------------------------|----------------------------------|
| ✖ Fully developed | ✖ Still in development! |
| 📅 Current built-in tool | 📱 New external tool |
| 🚫 No printing options | 🖨️ Print exam + key (instructor) |
| ⌚ Set extra time per quiz | ⌚ Set extra time once/course |
| ? Basic question types | ✖ Advanced question types |
| 🗄️ Simple question banks | 🏛️ Enhanced item banks |
| ⚠️ Shuffling requires banks | ✂️ One-click Q&A shuffling |

The new advanced question types include Categorization, Ordering, and Hot Spot, and Formula questions now support scientific notation.

To enable New Quizzes in your Canvas course:

1. Go to Settings, click Feature Previews, and click the red X next to New Quizzes to enable it:



- The next time you create a quiz, you will be prompted to choose a quiz engine:

Classic Quizzes
