



How to set up Outlook to Starfish Integration

By setting up Starfish and Outlook to sync together, you can avoid double-booking yourself. This also allows Outlook to tell Starfish when you are busy so that it can block off times in Starfish that you are unavailable to students. Students only see times they can sign up with you, they <u>do not</u> see your schedule or why you are unavailable.

- 1. Log in to Starfish (uccs.edu/Starfish or access via Canvas).
- 2. Click on the bars in the Upper left-hand corner on the Starfish site.



- 3. Set up your **Office Hours** in Starfish.

IMPORTANT: To ensure that Outlook will integrate correctly to Starfish, make sure that you have not reserved your Office Hours in Outlook. The only Office Hours that should appear in your Outlook (that you would like the ability for students to sign up for) are the ones that you set up in Starfish. Otherwise when you integrate Outlook with Starfish, it will look like you are busy during those times and students will not be able to sign up to meet with you.

4. Click on the bars in the Upper left-hand corner on the Starfish site.



- 5. Click on your name.
- 6. Click on Email Notifications.
- 7. Place a checkmark in the box next to Read busy times from my external Exchange calendar.
- 8. Click Submit.
- 9. Share your Microsoft365 (Outlook) calendar with Starfish.
 - a. Log in to your Microsoft365 email.
 - b. Click on your calendar.
 - c. Click on Share.



- d. In the "Enter an email address or a contact name" box, type in starfish@uccs.edu and click share.
